

Be very, very, very grateful that I remind you today, whether you are far or near to me, of my deep, personal, intimate love for you. I will never fail you. I will never forsake you. I will be with you always, says the Lord, until the end of time.

ASK ME TO HELP YOU

My people, it brings me great joy to see you here in this body. It brings me great joy. I want you to know that I love you. I love you with an everlasting love. Oh, if you only knew of my deep love for you, my everlasting love for you. I want you to know that I have so much more to give you, so much more I want to pour out into your life. You cannot even imagine. I want you to come and ask; there is nothing too small, there is nothing too great. I can do all things. Come to me first. Ask me to help you and give you the strength you need in all situations. Know that I love you with an everlasting love.

DO NOT FEAR AT ALL

My people, I love you. Do not fear; do not fear at all. You say, 'Lord, I'm unworthy and I'm a sinner.' But I have made you worthy. You say, 'But I'm limited.' And I tell you, I am not limited. I can come and be with you wherever you are.



PONDER AND CELEBRATE MY PRESENCE WITH YOU AND CELEBRATE THE LORD'S DAY

I was born of my Father's will. I walked among the people and performed miracles. I had the last supper with those closest to me and with the man who betrayed me. I was crucified, my body was broken, my blood poured out. I rose and I ascended. So, each time you come to the Eucharist, whether it be weekly or daily, ponder and think of all that I have done for you out of my Father's will. Ponder that my body and blood were poured out for you; my body was broken and my blood poured out. Ponder these things when your life is hard, when it's exciting, when it's neutral. Think about the last supper when I broke bread with my disciples and even with the one who betrayed me.

I also have given you the great gift of celebrating the Lord's Day. I ask you to celebrate the Lord's Day in your families and with each other. Even when you're tired and it's hard and you're not sure what you're putting on the table, celebrate. It's about being together in my presence in breaking bread, whether with a brother or sister that you're not particularly close to, or with those you're closest to. In all of this, ponder. Ponder deeply about my Eucharist, about the Corpus Christi, and ponder about the gifts I have given you in breaking bread together.
